## Dear Students & Parents,

The Jungle Committee is excited and ready to help you celebrate your graduation night! Below is a list of important information that you must know. PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!!

**DO...** eat before you arrive at the party. Food will be available around 9:00 p.m.

**DO...** bring your picture ID. **Arrive by 6:30 p.m. for check-in** at the WOHS-South building main entrance and then get in line for bus registration. Each bus will be assigned a color and will have a table for registration. You will be riding the ??? bus (to be determined).

**DO...** be on time!! You don't want to miss the opening festivities. The buses will not wait for late students and alternate transportation is not allowed.

**DO...** wear gym shoes or soft-soled shoes and dress comfortably. This is a night of active fun.

**DO...** bring your swimsuit, towel, and personal items in a plastic grocery bag or backpack. We will be collecting your bags for safekeeping until they are needed for swimming. We will provide a label for your bag.

**DO...** be respectful to parent volunteers, teachers, and site personnel. They are responsible for your safety as well as your fun on this evening. Courtesy is expected.

**DO NOT...** miss your chance to enjoy the evening. Misconduct includes smoking, alcohol, and illegal drugs on West Ottawa property (including buses) and at the Jungle site. Area police will be contacted and a parental pick-up will result. No refund will be given.

**DO NOT...** bring CD players, iPods, cell phones, cameras, or any other valuables. We will not be responsible for lost or stolen valuables. You will be asked to leave them behind before boarding the bus. Roving photographers will be on hand to take pictures of the event. The pictures will be available online at no charge, so you will not need a camera.

**DO NOT...** bring cash!! Your ticket price includes everything for the evening. There will be nothing to buy. We will not be responsible for lost or stolen cash.

At your own risk, cars may be left in the school parking lot overnight. Cars must be parked in the lot closest to the tennis courts/gym. The Ottawa County Sheriff's Department has been contacted to make random security checks, however it is recommended that you have a ride arranged instead. Pick-up time will be approximately 5:00 a.m. on June 8.
