Parents/Guardians of Kindergarten students at West Ottawa*

Welcome to West Ottawa Public Schools and the beginning of the school year for your Kindergarten student!

Your West Ottawa Public Schools Transportation Department is committed to providing a **safe** transportation system. Kindergarten students will be issued an identification nametag listing AM and PM bus number information (and any transfer information, if applicable). All Kindergarten students should have this important safety tool displayed on their backpack each day where it will be easy for bus drivers, teachers and other school staff to find it. This really helps us get them to the right location each day, especially for some of our more bashful students.

Once loaded on the bus, your Kindergartener will be assigned a seat near the front of the bus so we can help them find the right drop off point.

Listed below are some "*helpful tips*" to get your Kindergarten student off to a great start on the school bus:

- **In the AM...**

- ✓ Please make sure your child understands bus behavior expectations:
Be **Responsible**, **Respectful** and **Ready to Ride**.
- ✓ Talk to your child about our three primary bus safety rules:
 1. **Stay seated**, facing forward;
 2. Keep your **hands and personal belongings** to yourself; and
 3. **Obey your bus driver** at all times.
- ✓ Make sure your child **arrives at their assigned bus stop at least five (5) minutes before** the estimated time of AM pick-up. (*If your child is not at the bus stop when the bus arrives, the driver will make the stop, "count to ten" and proceed with the route.*)
- ✓ If your child must cross the street to get on the bus, wait for the bus to arrive, **watch for the overhead red lights** and then **wait for the bus driver to signal when it is safe to cross** (*using a green "Smile Face" crossing paddle*).

- **In the PM...**

- ✓ It is important that you make plans for receiving your Kindergartener at the bus stop.
- ✓ As a parent/guardian, you are responsible for the safety and conduct of your child at the bus stop – before the bus arrives in the AM and after the bus departs in the PM.

About two weeks prior to the start of the new school year, your child's bus stop information (*including pick-up and drop-off times and locations*) will be available online to parents/guardians through West Ottawa's **Infinite Campus Parent Portal** website. Bus stop information is updated frequently at the beginning of the school year. You are encouraged to check Parent Portal for the most current bus stop information over the weekend before the start of the new school year. Contact your elementary building secretary for assistance in creating/accessing your Parent Portal account.
