If you are engaging in virtual learning, you may feel free to call the office to arrange a time to pick up your order form or you can utilize the online option that was sent to each home via Infinite Campus. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to contact us.

During drop off and pick up, it is very important that parents stay in their vehicles. If you have to get out of the vehicle, please be sure to pull all the way to the end of the parking lot to avoid causing traffic issues. In addition, please do not block the entrance to the staff/bus lot. It is important that the busses can easily get in and out of the lot to assure timely transportation. Also, please do not park in the parent lot (south entrance) and drop off or pick up children. It is very dangerous for children to cross between the cars that are dropping off and picking up. Finally, for the safety of all, parents are not permitted to be on the sidewalk where children enter or exit. We are diligently trying to keep all of the children in their respective cohorts and when an outside presence enters the cohort, it adds additional safety concerns.

I realize that all of this is new and somewhat confusing, but every precaution that we have put in place revolves around the safety of our Lakewood community. This is very difficult for the Lakewood staff as well especially since Lakewood's culture is built around relationships. Hopefully what we are doing will keep everyone as safe as possible.

Environmental Club Of Lakewood (ECO Lakewood)


