

In our upper elementary classes, students created fall Haiku poems using Google Slides. Students then used Flipgrid to record and present these fun fall pieces!

Our lower elementary classes met Evo Ozobots. Ozobots help students learn and practice coding.

Evo is a tiny robot that can be programmed to perform complex maneuvers. Using markers, students were able to create codes to make Evo spin, speed, backwalk and create a "tornado!" Next week, the upper elementary class will be working with Evo!





