

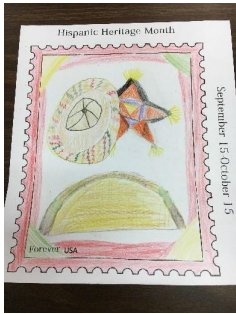


## SPANISH SPOTLIGHT WITH SEÑORA DILLON

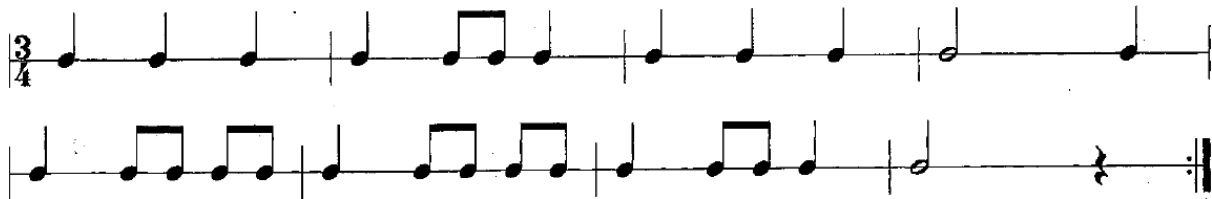
**from Mr. Loughrin**

Lakewood students are learning music notation through a program called “Rockin’ Rhythm Raps”. With this program, we focus on rhythm only, learning note values and their respective rests. 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade students are applying their understanding and composing their own Rock-in’ Rhythm Raps using a “rhythm puzzle” activity. We are then challenging our class to see if they can read our songs accurately. We are also seeing who can create the most interesting and most challenging rhythm patterns. We will be using half notes, half rests, quarter notes, quarter rests and sets of two eighth notes and even dotted half notes. Can you read the rhythm to this minuet written by Johann Sebastian Bach? (Don’t forget the repeat sign!)

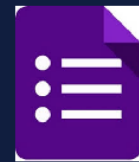

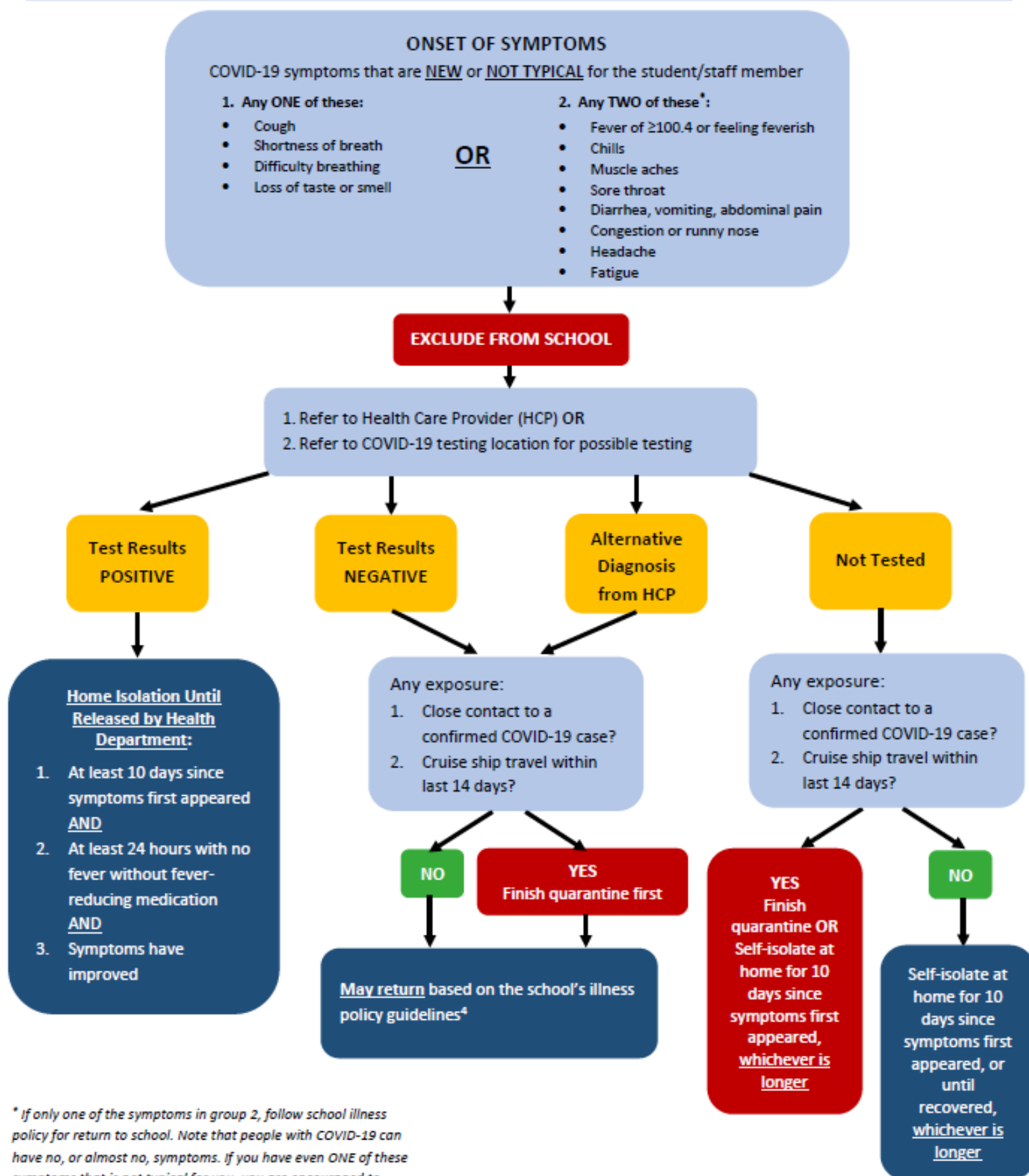
