# THE TECH LAB

Week of 3/15







This was the last week to identify mistakes in code using a fun debugging activity, then modify the code to run programs correctly. Students planned, tested and modified codes in order to solve an engineering challenge with Ozoblocky. We will revisit this skill again later on!

Students also focused on giving their own "Book Talk" recommendations using Flipgrid and AutroDraw. Students were encouraged to view other projects and add some books they found of interest to their "Must Read List!" We also are working on putting together a creative project where they will have a choice on how they want to present their "book of choice" using Google Suite tools.

Lower elementary students had the opportunity to visit Early World of Learning and talked about different ways to learn new things using technology. We shared some new facts that we learned regarding animals. After brainstorming some facts and opinions about their animal, students will be putting together a visual display to share!



# PICKING UP A STUDENT


If you need to pick up a student before normal dismissal time, please give the front office a call and email your student's teacher.

# SICK STUDENTS

Illness happens—we understand! If your student must stay home due to illness, please call the front office. Tell us your student's name, teacher, and symptoms.



If a student becomes ill while at school, we may send the student home for monitoring with a parent or guardian. Ensure your contact information and preferred emergency contacts are up to date in your student's file!



## **COVID-19 PROTOCOL**

A reality of this school year has been managing the outbreak of COVID-19.

Students exhibiting at least **one primary COVID-19 symptom** OR at least **two sec- ondary symptoms** must return home ASAP.
To return home, **students must**:

- Receive a negative COVID-19 test,
- Be signed off by a doctor (DO or MD), or
- Self-isolate for 10 days or until symptoms are gone—whichever is longer.

To return in less than 10 days, you **must** supply a negative test or doctor's note.






