Statement
<p>The administration may consider providing after school pupil transportation service to the Boys and Girls Club of Greater Holland, North Side Facility, other than a student’s official primary home address for students (grades 1-5) attending Great Lakes, Pine Creek or Woodside Elementary School. To be considered, the student must register with and be approved for transportation by the Boys and Girls Club in accordance with procedures established by the Boys and Girls Club and by the Director of Transportation.</p>
Procedures
<p>Pupil transportation service to the Boys and Girls Club of Greater Holland, North Side Facility, <i>may</i> only be granted under specific conditions. A parent or guardian should carefully consider whether each of the following conditions can be met before applying to the Boys and Girls Club for after school pupil transportation service to their North Side Facility:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupil transportation service to the Boys and Girls Club is available for students (grades 1-5) attending Great Lakes, Pine Creek or Woodside Elementary School as each of these schools have bus routes which pass by the North Side Facility. • If a parent or guardian chooses to have their student (grade 1-5) transported to the Boys and Girls Club after school, that choice will be for all after school transportation (Monday thru Friday) when school is in session. • Pupil transportation service to the Boys and Girls Club after school will only be provided when the request is for a consistent weekly basis, in the same manner for each school day of the week (Monday thru Friday). • Pupil transportation service to the Boys and Girls Club is available ONLY when the Boys and Girls Club is open. When the Boys and Girls Club is closed (due to anticipated schedule or unanticipated event), after school transportation must be provided by the parent or guardian. • If a student, who is approved for and assigned pupil transportation to the Boys and Girls Club, is suspended by or restricted from attending the Boys and Girls Club for a temporary period of time, the parent or guardian must provide after school transportation. • A parent or guardian applies for after school transportation to the Boys and Girls Club on an annual basis, on a timeline, and in accordance with procedures established by the Boys and Girls Club and by the Director of Transportation. Approved requests expire at the end of the school year and must be resubmitted to the Boys and Girls Club each new school year. <p>For more information on a variety of transportation issues, please refer to the Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) tab on the Transportation Department website.</p>
