WO Transportation – A Great Place to Work!

Becoming a school bus driver at West Ottawa Public Schools is a great job that is now more financially rewarding than ever. Here at WO, we offer the following to school bus drivers:

Our 2023-2024 Pay Schedule for sub and regular drivers is as follows:

Sub bus driver trainee, training rate (no CDL)	\$17.77 /hr
Sub bus driver trainee, training rate (with CDL)	\$18.77 /hr
• Sub bus driver, regular rate (completion of GDTP Levels 1-5)	\$19.77 /hr
Regular bus driver, first year (driving rate)	
• Regular bus driver, 2 or more years of experience (driving rate)	\$20.29-\$24.97 /hr
Notes: A graduated pay advancement schedule for new bus driver training provides incentive for obtaining	
a CDL and for timely completion of the Graduated Driver Training Program (GDTP).	

Our new hire and regular bus driver **Attendance Incentives** are as follows:

- New hires will be paid \$500 after they have driven on their own for fifty (50) school days and an additional \$1,000 after they have driven on their own for one-hundred and eighty (180) school days.
- Regular bus drivers shall receive an attendance incentive based on the number of sick days used during each of three (3) designated periods:
 - 1. From the first day of work for the school year through November 30: (Zero (0) days used, \$150; One (1) day or partial day used, \$75)
 - 2. From December 1 through the last school day before Spring Break: (Zero (0) days used, \$150; One (1) day or partial day used, \$75)
 - 3. From Spring Break through the last school day for the school year: (Zero (0) days used, **\$150**; One (1) day or partial day used, \$75)

Other Pay Benefits:

- Regular bus drivers at WO receive **five (5) days of pay during Spring Break** (plus two additional days during Winter Holiday Break for those with 6 or more years of experience).
- Regular bus drivers at WO receive three (3) personal paid days during the school year.
- Regular bus drivers at WO receive **two (2) paid snow days** (when used) and can **receive pay on additional snow days** from available accrued personal or sick time up to the maximum number of days allowed by law.
- Regular bus drivers at WO accrue sick leave each month to help provide income when sick and unable to work.
- Regular bus drivers at WO who work 30 or more assigned hours per week are **eligible for certain health insurance benefits** or can take a **lucrative 'cash in lieu'**.
- Regular bus drivers at WO can increase their work hours to 30 or more hours per week by working in the Food Service department between runs.
- Regular bus drivers at WO can further supplement their income by taking day or night trips.
